*Either a Home Performance Assessment or a Rating is required to qualify for these Cash-Back Rewards. In order to receive the current level of Cash-Back Rewards, consumers must complete the recommended improvements and have the post-test done in the current program year. Cash-Back Rewards cannot exceed installed cost.

** Homes receiving electricity and natural gas service from a participating utility, but heat with oil or LP, are eligible to receive "electric only" Cash-Back Rewards as stated in column one in the above table.

Homes being heated with more than 50% electric heat in eligible Focus on Energy territories are eligible for all Cash-Back Rewards in the above table.

Due to the fact that Focus on Energy is a public benefits program mandated by legislation and overseen by the Public Service Commission (PSC), investor-owned utilities (IOUs) are required to participate in the program. Wisconsin's municipal utilities and electric cooperatives have the option of participating in the state program or operating their own "commitment-to-community" programs, which are similar to Focus on Energy. Thus, Focus on Energy Cash-Back Rewards eligibility is based on participating electric and gas utility service areas.
